BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Please complete the Booking Form FULLY and return it to us, together with a £40 per week, per pitch deposit. Please note we cannot refund pitch deposits. We are bound to reserve you a Pitch when we send you Confirmation. There is a 2% surcharge for all credit card payments.
- You are to pay the Balance no less than 28 days prior to arrival. Confirmation will be sent to you on receipt of your final remittance, please bring this with you as proof of payment.
- In the event of cancellation 21 days or more before arrival, the Balance of the Holiday payment will be refunded, less deposit. Cancellations less than 21 days prior to arrival will be charged 50% of total booking cost. This cancellation policy does not apply to the following circumstances; death or serious injury to close relative or death of partner, business associate or any member of your party. We will try to accommodate revision of Holiday dates where possible. We strongly advise customers to purchase Holiday Insurance covering Curtailment. Refunds will not be given for unused nights.
- Beacon Hill Touring Park accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to property whilst staying at the park including damage caused by trees or parts falling there from.
- The management reserves the right to refuse admission. We do not accept groups of young people during High Season. A £30 Behaviour Bond will be charged per head (refundable on departure) on all unaccompanied young people, single sex parties and other groups at management discretion. We may decide to levy a Noise Disturbance Bond at £50 per family for family group bookings (refundable on departure).
- Any conduct which constitutes anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated. PAYMENT IS ACCEPTED ON CONDITION THAT OUR RULES AND BOOKING CONDITIONS ARE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. We reserve the right to ask you to leave the Park if the behaviour of any member of your party is unacceptable to us. In these circumstances Beacon Hill Touring Park shall not be under any liability to the persons involved and shall be discharged from any further performance of its obligations. Designated Security Officers have management control during out of hours. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
- We are unable to guarantee the allocation of a specific pitch, although every effort will be made to meet your request.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

These rules, which are designed to benefit all bona fide campers and caravanners, set out general standards of conduct and behaviour expected of them.

Payment can be made by cheque, credit/debit card, traveller's cheque or cash. There is a 2% surcharge for all credit card payments. Any receipt for payment should be retained throughout your stay.

Admission to the site implies a commitment to uphold the internal rules of the park. On arrival, campers should report to reception. Late arrivals should pitch quietly with due consideration, and report to reception the following morning. Any conduct which constitutes anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated. The management will not accept liability of any description for the person or property of any person using the park. Trading on the site is forbidden except when authorised in writing by the management.

The Pitch must be kept clean and tidy, with the minimum of spare equipment stored neatly outside. Tents or caravans should be pitched only as illustrated in our Site Map guide, with caravan tow bars facing the roadways, unless otherwise agreed with management. We do not allow the use of high powered domestic electrical equipment or awning heaters.

Vehicles may be driven only directly between the site entrance and the pitch, and must never be driven above **5mph** within the park confines. It is essential to avoid leaving the engine running and to ensure minimum access during evening hours. Vehicles should be parked as close to the pitch as possible, but in any event must not encroach on neighbouring pitches. We do not allow car washing on site.

Sanitation & Refuse. Chemical toilets and waste water containers **must** be emptied only in designated waste disposal facilities. Refuse must be placed in the relevant receptacles provided. Ensure to use the recycle bins for paper, glass, cans and plastic.

Laundry. The washing of clothes and dishes is forbidden at field taps and washroom hand wash basins. Laundry and washing up facilities are available. Washing should be hung out to dry in a discreet manner. No drying lines to exceed the width of the tent or caravan.

Fires. The lighting of ground fires is strictly forbidden. Raised barbeque units are permitted, provided they are kept well away from trees, shrubs and other combustibles. Anyone found to be lighting ground fires will be asked to leave the site, no refunds will be given.

Dogs must always be kept on a leash and under proper control. They must not be allowed to foul the park or become a nuisance and should only be exercised off the site. Any owner allowing their animal to become a nuisance or foul the site may be asked to leave. Animals are not allowed in any of the buildings.

Noise & Nuisance. Musical instruments, radios, CD players and similar appliances should be used considerately during the day and not at all after 10pm. All noise should be kept to an absolute minimum after 11pm. Bad language will NOT be tolerated. Children must be under the supervision of their parents or guardians at all times, especially around the swimming pool, fishing lakes and play areas. Anyone found to be vandalising or thieving in any case will be asked to leave the park, no refunds will be given.

Games. Any games, particularly ball games, which might annoy or inconvenience others, are forbidden except in the areas provided.

Respect the site and its environment. Do not damage plants, trees, grass or drop litter.

Departure. You should leave the site by 11am. Ensure that the pitch is left as you found it on arrival, should you wish to extend your stay please check availability with reception before 10am on your day of departure.

Accommodation on the site is given provided that all the rules and instructions herein are observed. Any person in breach of these rules may be asked to leave the site.
